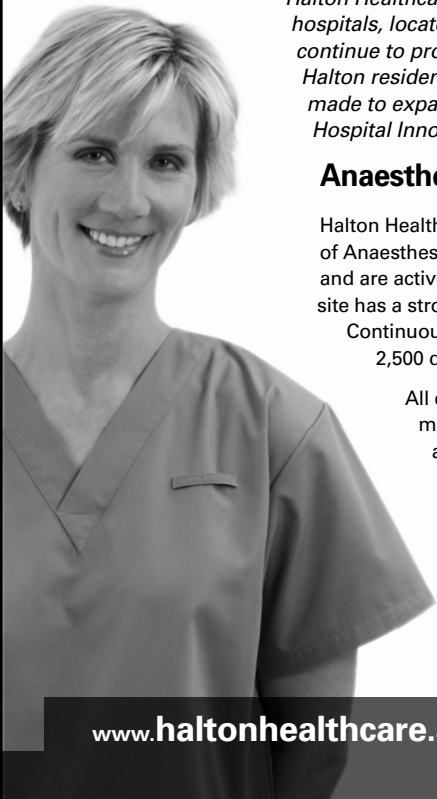


# GROW YOUR CAREER. *Live the lifestyle.*

## **Anaesthesiologist**

Halton Healthcare Services has an exciting opportunity for a full-time Anaesthesiologist in the Department of Anaesthesia at our Oakville site. We provide approximately 10,000 anaesthetics per year in 7 OR suites, and are active in all surgical subspecialties, with the exception of cardiac and neurosurgery. Our Oakville site has a strong, well-established Acute Pain Service providing PCA, Continuous Epidural Analgesia and Continuous Nerve Blocks. There is an active Pre-Admission Clinic, and we see approximately 2,500 deliveries per year.

All qualified physicians are invited to participate in the selection process. Successful candidates must have a licence to practice in Ontario and be Board certified by the RCPSC. We thank all applicants for their submissions. However, only candidates felt most appropriate for the position will be selected for interview. All appointments are subject to Board Approval.
