Our commitment to live the values of HHS translates into quality care where the health and wellbeing of the mother, infant, child and their families is our prime concern and source of pride.

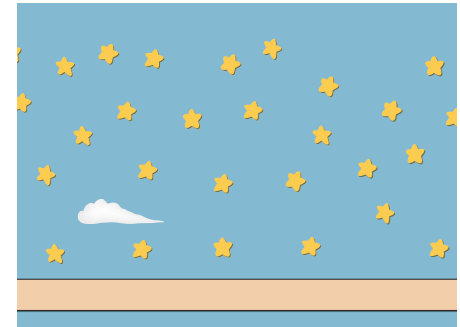
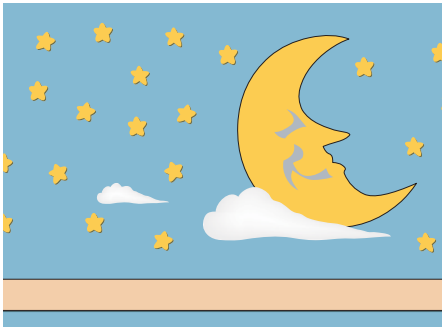
The Maternal Child Program at OTMH has a rich history... and your family is a part of it.

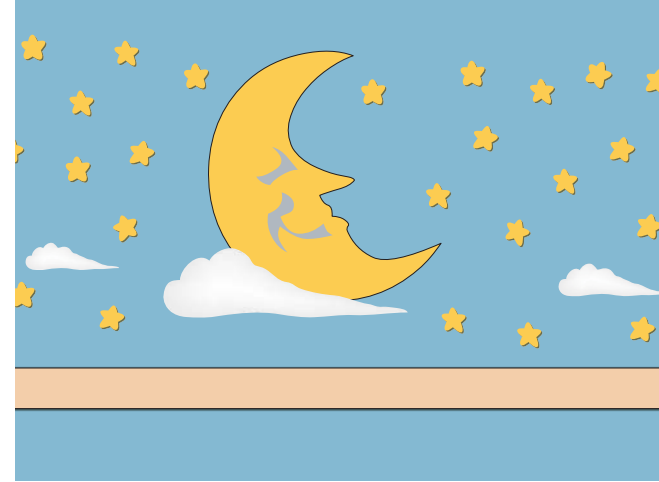
