



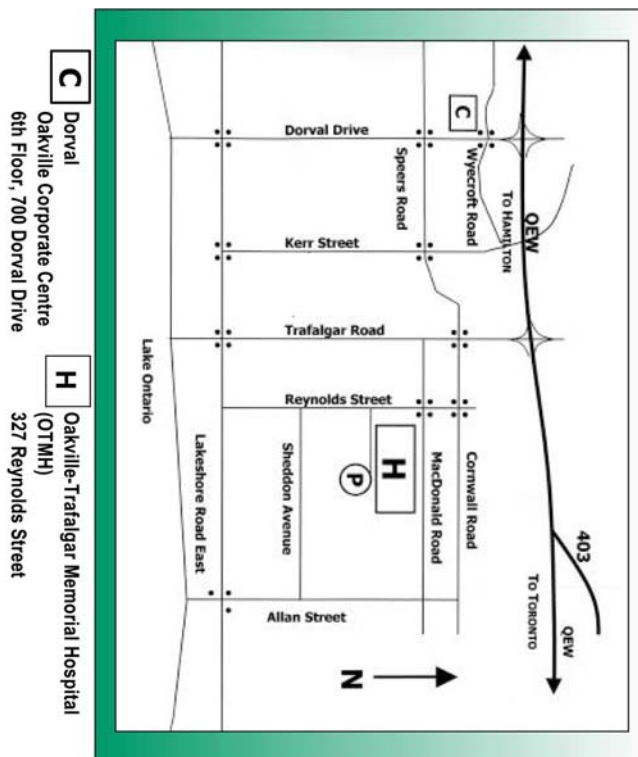

COMMUNITY SUPPORT TEAM

Community Support Team (C.S.T.) is an adult, outpatient, community based, clinical multi-disciplinary case management team for individuals with severe and persistent mental illness.

Also provided:

- Community Treatment Order consultations/team management
- Homelessness Initiative clinical support

THE TREATMENT STAFF

C.S.T. is staffed by a multi-disciplinary team including nurses and social workers.

CRITERIA

- Resident of Oakville
- Minimum age 18
- Established diagnosis of schizophrenia, other psychoses, major mood disorder with or without co-existing personality disorder, dual diagnosis, concurrent disorder
- Residual and/or recurrent functional impairment which persist despite treatment and which produce significant disability in daily living

REFERRAL SOURCES

- Inpatient Psychiatry
- Halton Healthcare psychiatrist and general practitioner, Central Intake Service

GOAL

To assist adults disabled with severe, persistent mental illness to attain and maintain maximum self-sufficiency, stability and integration in community living.

TREATMENT

- Intake assessment by assigned case manager
- Clinical assessment and monitoring
- Treatment based on individual needs/goals including counselling and psychoeducation
- Provide support/assistance with activities of daily living and linkages to housing, leisure, social and vocational needs.
- Family/caretaker support
- Crisis intervention and support
- Liaise with Medication Clinic, psychiatrists, family physicians and others within circle of care
- Office, home and community visits as arranged

COMMUNITY SUPPORT TEAM SERVICES

Ongoing as long as the client needs support.

Discharge occurs when client:

- moves outside Oakville
- refuses or no longer requires service
- demonstrates ongoing violent or aggressive behaviour

COST OF PROGRAM

Our services are provided through Halton Healthcare Services and indirectly through the Ministry of Health. There is no additional fee for service.
